

DECLARATION of the VI International Congress of the World Society for the Study, Preservation and Popularization of the Cultural Heritage of Uzbekistan

We, participants of the VI International Congress, in recent years

We would like to emphasize that special attention is paid to the support, preservation and study of cultural heritage in Uzbekistan, and profound changes are taking place in the field of science and culture. New Uzbekistan is confidently strengthening its position in the international arena as a country with an incomparable heritage and high scientific potential.

With the direct initiative of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, Shavkat Mirmonovich Mirziyoyev, the foundation of the New Renaissance - the New Renaissance is being laid in Uzbekistan, which is also reflected in the fact that fundamental changes are being implemented in the spiritual and educational sphere.

Large-scale events are being organized and held in the field of social sciences and culture, a 10-year State program on improving the activities of state museums and strengthening their material and technical base in 2017-2027 was adopted. In particular, 7 new museums are being established in Samarkand this year alone. in Paris

Accepting Uzbekistan's election to the UNESCO Intergovernmental Committee for the Protection of Intangible Cultural Heritage at the 9th session of the General Assembly of States Parties to the Convention "On the Protection of Intangible Cultural Heritage" as an important recognition of our country's efforts to preserve the unique cultural heritage of the past centuries possible 60 volumes of the exclusive international series "Cultural Heritage of Uzbekistan" were published during the six-year activity of the World Society for the Preservation, Study and Popularization of the Cultural Heritage of Uzbekistan. Publication of the series "Inscriptions on the Monuments of Uzbekistan", "Uzbekistan's Science and Culture in the Works of Scientists" continues, more than 60 films have been shot, and many media forums have been held in Uzbekistan and abroad. This action program, which provides effective communication between scientists and researchers, was implemented with the support of the President and Government of the Republic of Uzbekistan, socially responsible business representatives such as Eriell Group, and a number of international humanitarian organizations.

On July 22-24, 2022, the VI Congress of the World Society for the Study, Preservation and Popularization of the Cultural Heritage of Uzbekistan, held in the

city of Samarkand, brought together 350 participants from 32 countries and became an important event in the world of science. More than 100 lectures, round talks, sessions were held. At this point, we should emphasize that the geography of the project is expanding more and more. For the first time, scientists from almost all countries of Central Asia participated in the work of the VI Congress.

We welcome the initiative of the Government of Uzbekistan to publish the first 35 volumes of this series and distribute them to all educational institutions of Uzbekistan. This initiative is an important step in improving the spirituality of the modern generation and should be an example for other countries.

At the same time, it should be noted that the world community shows a high interest in the books published by the World Society, as well as in their wider distribution to the largest scientific institutions, libraries and museums.

We express our deep gratitude to the President and the Government of the Republic of Uzbekistan for their constant support of initiatives aimed at the continuous development of the sphere of culture, social sciences, and the preservation of the cultural heritage of the peoples of Uzbekistan.
