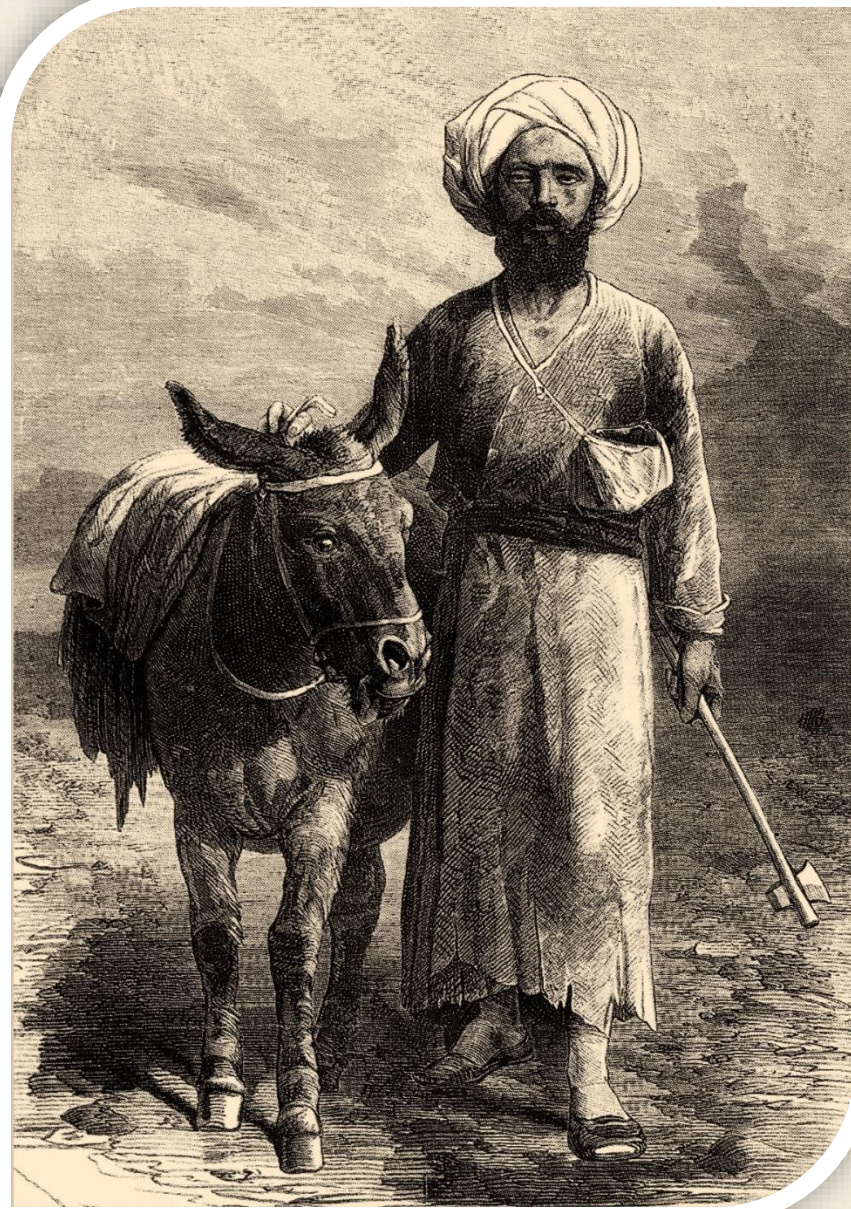

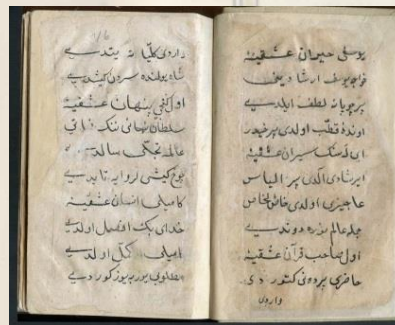

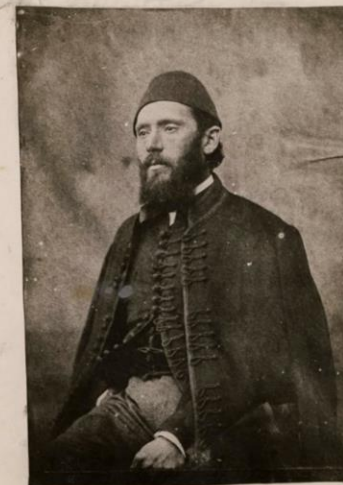

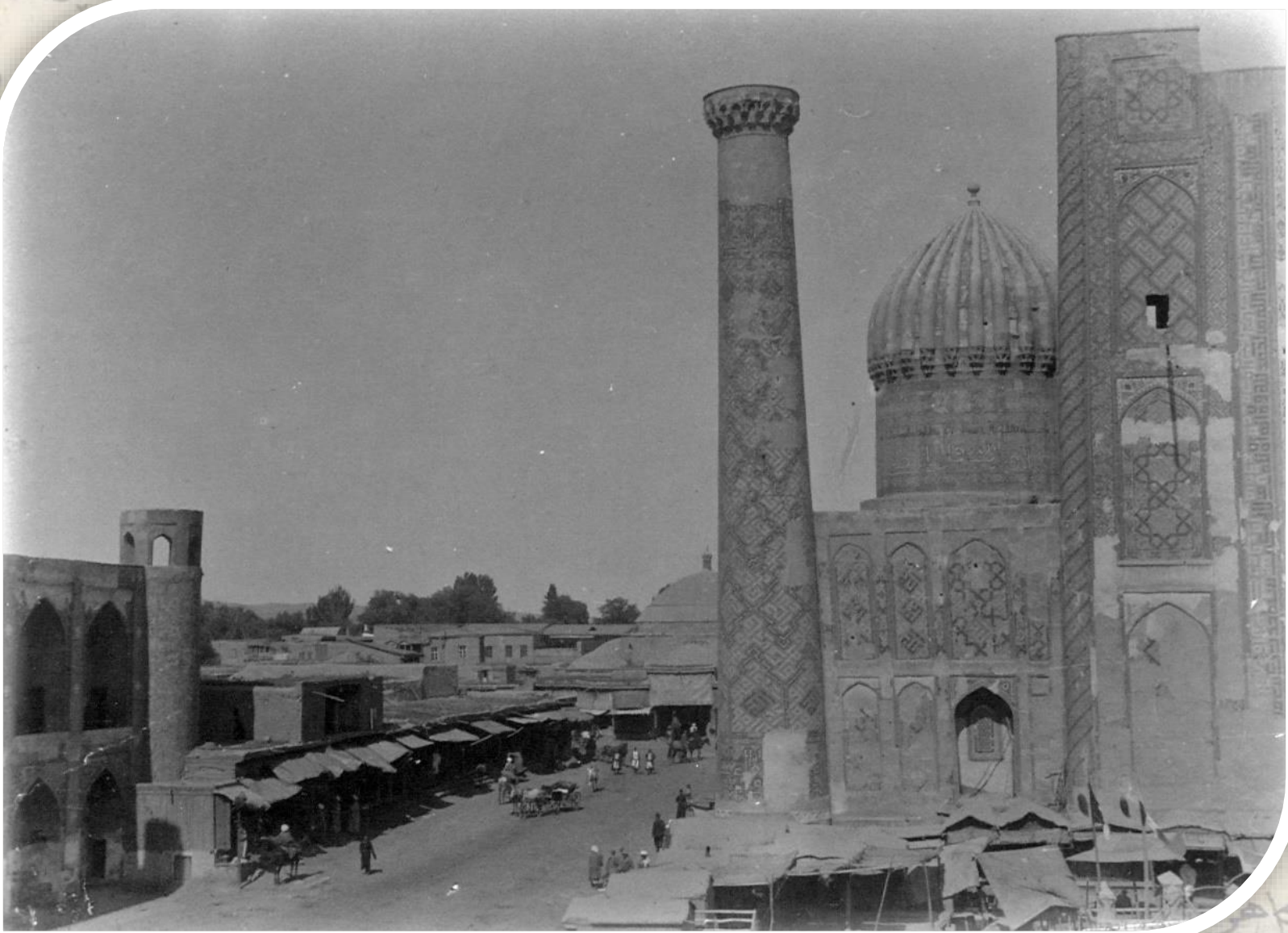

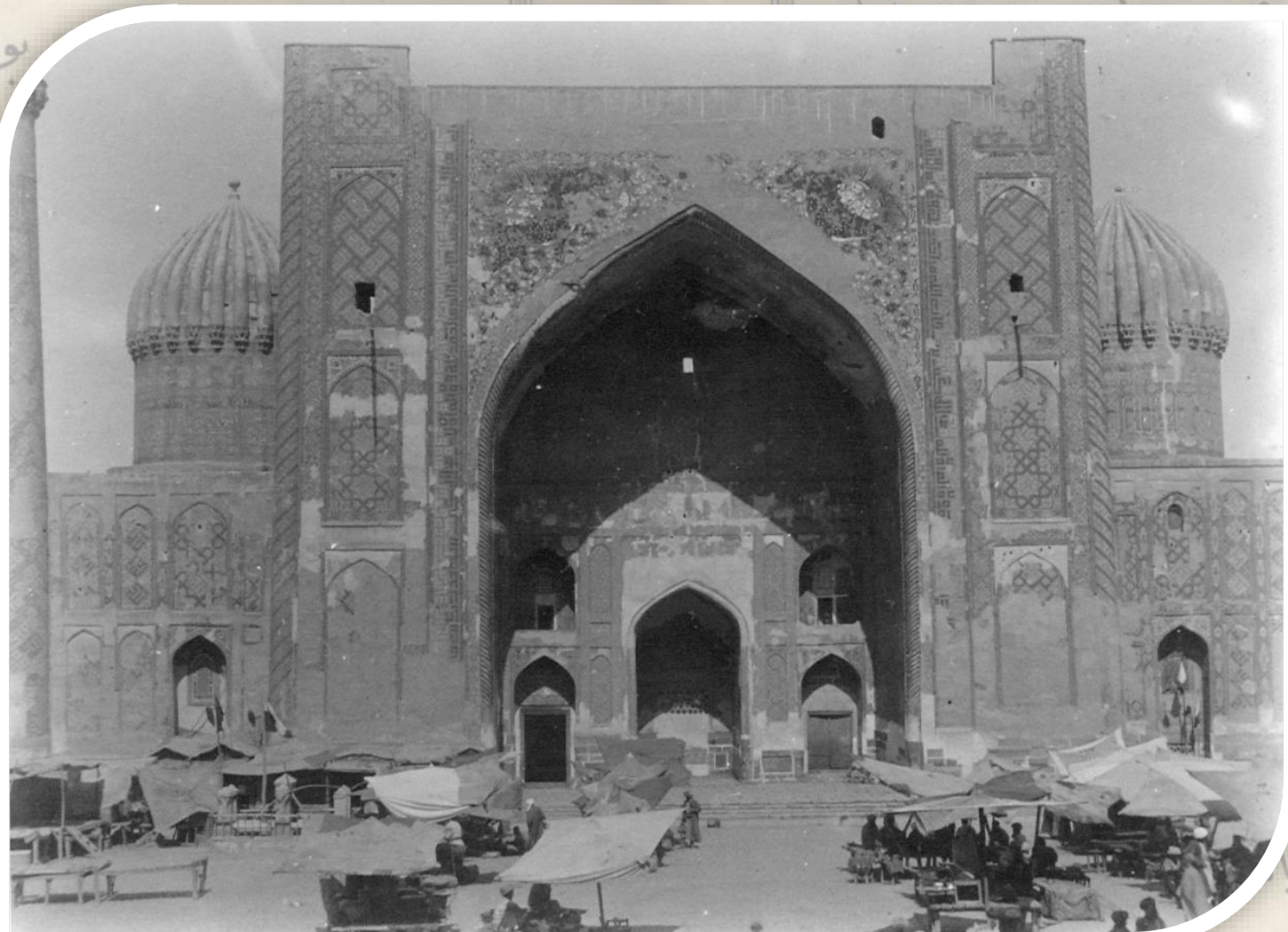


Manuscript of the travelogue of the first expedition
